The Client now intends to establish a shortlist of qualified and competent consultants, with a view to inviting proposals from the shortlisted consultants, in relation to the assignment, on the basis of the procurement documentation provided in ECEPP for this assignment. The selection method (procurement method) is shown above and interested firms or groups of firms are hereby invited to submit expressions of interest.

The expected outcome of the assignment is as follows:

The main objective of the assignment is for the Consultant to assist the Client in the administration of the Bank-funded works contracts (hereinafter also referred to as "the Contract"), carry out the duties of the 'Engineer' assigned to him in the works contracts and to undertake the role of the "Engineer" as defined in terms of FIDIC Conditions of Contract for Plant and Design-Build; for Electrical and Mechanical Plant, and for Building and Engineering Work, First Edition 1999, as well as to ensure the Independent Construction Supervision in accordance with the legal provisions in this field.

The selected consultant is expected to provide the following services:

More specifically, the scope of the consultancy assignment will be as follows:

- i) to ensure that high quality construction is achieved and that all works are carried out in full compliance with the design, specifications and other civil works contract documents;
- ii) to ensure the timely completion of the civil works;
- iii) to ensure compliance with safeguards, including the management of environmental mitigation plans;
- iv) coordinating with all subjects during construction period and preparing of the monthly, final and additional reports as per Client's requirements, what understand an adequate knowledge of Bosnian and English language (spoken and written);
- v) to act as Reviewer of Design (in local language "Reviewer of Design" - "Revident projekta") (designed by the Contractor) and Supervisor of construction works in accordance with the laws of the Federation of BiH relevant to the supervision of the works and review of design (in local language "review of design" - "Revizija projekta").
- vi) to implement all activities in accordance with BiH relevant legislation.

The assignment is expected to start on 28/06/2019 and have an estimated overall duration of 45 months.
